BEE DISEASE INSURANCE (BDI)

Up to 3 colonies are included in the Registered and Junior subscriptions.

BDI cover only becomes operative after 3 months following receipt of your subscription.

When insuring, potential increase must be taken into consideration, this includes nuclei and swarms.
If the number of colonies managed exceeds the number of colonies for which the premium has been paid, no cover will apply under the BDI policy.

Premiums for additional colonies, up to a maximum of 39, are shown below.
