- A. Dundee Cake
(made to a given recipe)

Ingredients:

7oz plain flour
1 teasp baking powder
6oz butter or margarine
5oz sugar
3 large eggs
6oz sultanas
6oz currants
6oz raisins
1oz glace cherries (cut up)
1½oz mixed peel
2oz ground almonds
Grated rind of lemon
2oz almonds, blanched
1tbsp sherry

Method:

Cream fat and sugar, mix in small quantity of flour, add eggs one at a time, gradually mix in more flour, add ground almonds, sherry and fruit. Put in lined 8in (approx) cake tin. Place blanched almonds on top. Bake in a moderately slow oven for 1½ - 2 hours.

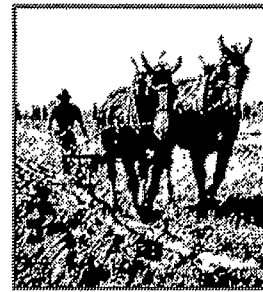
