## A. Apple Sauce Cake

(made to a given recipe)
Ingredients:
7 za S R flour $\quad 1 / 4$ teasp salt
1 teasp baking powder 4 oz butter
1 teasp cinnamon 3 eggs
$1 / 2$ teasp ground cloves 4 oz raisins $50 z$ soft brown sugar $40 z$ walnuts, chopped 9 fl oz Apple Sauce (see below)

## Apple Sauce

1 lb cooking apples, peeled, cored and sliced Finely grated rind 1 lemon
2 tabsp lemon juice
2 tabsp sugar, or to taste
2 tabsp water
1 oz butter, cut into small pieces
Place apples in large pan with lemon juice, rind, sugar and water. Bring to boil, reduce heat, cover and simmer for 20 mins or till soft. Sieve or blend to puree, then beat in butter

## Method:

Grease and line 8" (approx) cake tin with greaseproof paper, greased. Sift flour, salt, baking powder, cinnamon and cloves into a bowl. Cream butter and sugar. Beat in eggs one at a time, adding a little flour with each. Fold in remaining flour. Stir in raisins, nuts and apple sauce. Pour into cake tin. Bake in centre of oven ( $350^{\circ} \mathrm{F}, 180^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$, Gas Mark 4) for 50 mins or till cooked. (Test with skewer) Leave 5 mins and turn out on wire rack.
